Completion of Roadmap to Success


Description of Trend:

Performance worsened from 91.0% to 89.9% in July 2019. The goal was missed by 0.1 percentage points.

Numerator: (of those in the denominator) the number of youth who have a completed Roadmap to Success (ILP)

<u>Denominator</u>: all youth in outof-home care who are at least age 14 plus 60 days and who have been in out-of-home care for at least 60 days

Denominator: 1,159
